Constructing Population Pyramids

Use the following link, and compare and contrast two countries (one MDC, one LDC) after constructing the population pyramids from the data. https://www.census.gov/population/international/data/idb/informationGateway.php

Steps to follow for each country:

- 1. Under Select Reports, choose Population by 5 Year Age Groups
- 2. Select one country, the year 2010 and *Show Individual Country Data Only*
- 3. Once you submit, you see your population pyramid in number form.
- 4. Complete the same steps above for your second country

The population pyramids you create must be in percentages for each side of the graph paper. The way to figure out the percentage is to take the age data from 0-4 year olds (for example) and divide it by the total female population. You need to do the conversion for EVERY AGE GROUPING AND SEX.

You will submit: both population pyramids as well as the written analysis on Google Classroom.
