Characteristics of religions

Set of beliefs relating to god/s

Structure of hierarchy of officials

Monotheistic vs Polytheistic

Belief in singular god vs multiple gods

Ethnic Religions

Members are born into faith

Converts NOT actively sought

Spread mainly by relocation diffusion

Ex: Judaism, Hinduism

Universalizing Religions

Belief system that one's religion is the one true religion

Missionary and evangelical work to actively seek converts

Spread mainly through expansion diffusion

Ex: Christianity, Buddhism, Islam

Divisions within faiths

Branches

Large division within a religion (Christianity)

Denominations

Division that unites a number of local congregations into a single administrative body (Baptists, Lutherans and Calvinists are all denominations of Protestantism)

Sects

Refers to a few different ideas:

Relatively small group that broke away from a bigger group

An organized ecclesiastical body

A dissenting or schismatic body

Religious Fundamentalism

Strict adherence to the essential principles of a religion often including intolerance of other views and opposition to secularism

Often seen as a response to Western Materialism

Religious Extremism

Fundamentalism carried out the point of violence

Secularism

Indifference or rejection of organized religious affiliations and ideas Anti-religious ideas can contribute to decline of organized religion
